Summary

FSU Street Team Volunteers (Volunteers) support a variety of FSU initiatives, events, services, campaigns, and student engagement opportunities while developing leadership, communication, teamwork, and professional skills. They participate in a variety of volunteer opportunities within the FSU and jointly within Fanshawe College and outside organizations.

FSU Street Team Duties

- Interacts and builds good rapport with students and entire FSU Volunteer team
- Collects and reports feedback to improve students' attendance and participation
- Provides a safe and welcoming environment for all
- Supports FSU events, services and student engagement activities
- Assists with event setup, registration, wayfinding, facilitation and teardown when required
- Communicates promptly with supervisors regarding attendance, availability or concerns
- Complies with all applicable FSU and Fanshawe College policies and procedures
- Respects the confidentiality and privacy of personal, student and organizational information
- Takes reasonable precautions to ensure their own safety and the safety of others



Volunteer Requirements

- Full-time post-secondary student at Fanshawe College
- Attends and completes required orientation and training
- Follows health and safety rules and policies
- Attend training/orientation for their assigned volunteer role.
- Must be willing to meet the time commitment requirements associated with assigned FSU Volunteer opportunities and shifts, usually 2-4 shifts per months.

FSU Volunteers are required to review and sign additional documents such as a Waiver and Release of Liability Form, Photo Release Form and will be assigned Health and Safety training, FSU Leadership Modules and role-specific training prior to beginning their role.

Work Conditions

- Interact directly with students, staff and management
- Some repetitive work
- FSU Volunteer assignments and hours vary depending on program and event needs
- Some initiatives may be scheduled on and evenings weekends
- FSU Volunteer opportunities are assigned based on program needs and FSU Volunteer availability
- Outdoor assignments may occur depending on the nature of the activities
