- Interacts and builds good rapport with students and volunteer team
- Collect and reports feedback to improve students' attendance and participation
- Works collaboratively and follow directions from designated FSU Staff and VP, Student Life.
- Commits to assigned volunteer time
- Provides a safe and welcoming environment for all
- Follows health and safety rules and policies



Volunteer Requirements

- Full-time post-secondary student at Fanshawe College
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Punctual and responsible
- Must be available to participate in an interview process and if chosen, attend training/orientation for their assigned volunteer role.
- Must be able to meet the minimum time commitment for the role -2-4 shifts per. Month

Volunteers are required to review and sign additional documents such as a Waiver and Release of Liability Form, Photo Release Form and will be assigned FSU Leadership Modules and Health and Safety training prior to beginning their role.

Work Conditions

- May work in the front line or back end of the events
- Interacts directly with students, staff and management
- Some repetitive work
- Volunteer hours vary depending on the type of event.
- Some initiatives may be scheduled on weekends and evenings.
